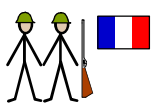
Jean Giraudoux belonged to the 176th Régiment d'infanterie.

His regiment arrived in Gallipoli in May 1915.



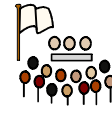
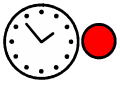
He was wounded but refused to leave the trenches.



He was wounded again several hours later.



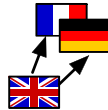
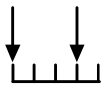
He was awarded a medal for his courage.



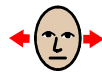
After the war he worked for the government.
